

Archbishop Tenison's School Homework

Homework is central to the school's aim of 'academic excellence'. It is essential that teachers set homework regularly and consistently so that pupils and students can establish good routines, giving them the capacity to work independently through their time at Archbishop Tenison's and beyond.

We set homework to:

- Foster the ability to work independently.
- Help pupils reflect on, and consolidate, what they have learned.
- Move their learning beyond the confines of the classroom.

Principles for staff setting homework

- Keep it simple.
- Make it predictable.
- Make it matter (e.g. in the next lesson).
- See homework as delegating a task.
- Keep it varied (e.g. prepare / remember / practise / revise)
- Insist that it is done.
- Recognise it when it is done well.

A Homework Timetable will be produced at the beginning of each year to ensure that the total amount of homework set for students is consistent and manageable for them.

Homework will be set in the Assignments area of each Class Team and a hand in date will be indicated when the homework is set.
