

## FREE SCHOOL MEALS APPLICATION FORM 2021/22

If you currently receive housing or council tax benefit through Croydon Council, you do **NOT** need to complete this form. Your child's entitlement to free school meals will be processed by the housing benefit section and the school and yourself notified.

CHILDREN WHOSE PARENTS/CARERS RECEIVE THE FOLLOWING **MAY** BE ENTITLED TO FREE SCHOOL MEALS:

- Income support
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income-based job seeker's allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- The guarantee element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190 as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs. **(If you receive working tax credit as well as child tax credit you will NOT be entitled to free school meals).**
- Financially supported by NASS (National Asylum Support Service)

**NOTE:**

- Please note if you are in receipt of working tax credits you will **NOT** be entitled to a free school meal.
- If your child is eligible for and getting free school meals on 31 March 2018, they'll remain eligible until 31 March 2022 regardless if your income changes

Administration of free school meals is undertaken by Croydon housing benefits section for pupils attending a school within Croydon. **Please complete the form and return to Mrs Viljoen at Archbishop Tenison's School for processing with Croydon Council.**
